

## Master of Science in Kinesiology: Program Planning

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**Pre-requisite Coursework:** Human Anatomy, Human Physiology, Ex. Physiology, Structural Kinesiology/Biomechanics, Motor Learning/Development, Ex. Psychology **(Must have a B- or better)**

A student with a bachelor's degree in a field other kinesiology **will be** required to complete foundational upper division coursework in kinesiology. Students with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology **may be** required to complete foundational coursework depending on their undergraduate courses listed and program objectives.

**Graduate Record Exam (GRE) Targets:** Verbal (148), Quantitative (140), Writing (3.5).

**TOEFL:** 550 minimum or 213 for computer version for international students.

**GPA** of 2.75 in last 60 semester units, 3.0 is preferred.
